To that end, Viventium has conducted a very informative, two-part webinar series called **Foraging Through Forgiveness: Maximizing Your SBA Grant**, which provides a detailed explanation of the recent Paycheck Protection Program Flexibility Act (PPPFA), signed into law on June 5, 2020, in a simplified way anyone can understand. The PPPFA includes provisions that offer flexibility to previous regulations that may greatly increase employers' probability of obtaining Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loan forgiveness.

## Here are some of the key points covered in the webinar:

- "Covered Period" for use of funds extended from 8 to 24 weeks (or Dec. 31, 2020, whichever is earlier)
- Employee cash compensation cap likely to be increased from \$15,385 to \$46,154
- Reduction of the percentage of loan funds that must be spent on payroll from 75% to 60% (Non-payroll costs allowed increase from 25% to 40%)
- Headcount/wage level restoration date extended from June 30, 2020, to December 31, 2020, and a new safe harbor introduced
- CARES Act employer social security deferral allowed, even with PPP loan forgiveness
